You might have seen that the Scottish Learning Disabilities Observatory released some research into how COVID-19 impacts people with a learning disability.

Because of this research there is now evidence to show that people with a learning disability are at higher risk of becoming seriously unwell if they catch COVID-19.





If you would like you can speak to your GP about the vaccine.

You should call your GP surgery and ask to speak with your doctor.

You should tell the person that you have a learning disability and would like to speak to your doctor about the COVID-19 vaccine.



They should make an appointment for you to speak to your doctor.

Your appointment will most likely be over the phone.



When on the phone you should tell the doctor that you want to be considered for getting the COVID-19 vaccine as part of the JCVI Priority Group 6.

This is because of the evidence that people with a learning disability face greater risk and health inequalities when it comes to COVID-19.


This Annex says that information and evidence should be used to improve vaccine uptake and reduce inequalities in the implementation of the COVID-19 immunisation programme.



You should ask your doctor to consider giving you the COVID-19 vaccine because of these things.

They will tell you if they will agree to consider you for the vaccine.





Your GP will tell you if they will consider giving you the vaccine as part of this group.

They will make this decision.



Right now GPs do not have to give you the vaccine in this group. They can say you should wait until other people the same age as you are offered the vaccine.
